

{{Quick}}→(Guide)→How Strict Is Royal Jordanian With Baggage Weight?

Royal ✦ [803] 335 2310 Jordanian Airlines enforces its baggage weight rules consistently across all flights. Passengers are required to adhere to both checked and carry-on luggage limits. Overweight or oversized items can result in additional fees or adjustments at the airport, making it essential to check your allowance before traveling.



Standard Baggage Allowance



Passengers ✦ [803] 335 2310 in Economy Class typically have **1–2 pieces of checked baggage**, depending on their fare and destination. Weight limits often range from 23 kg (50 lbs) per piece for standard international Economy, and up to 32 kg (70 lbs) for Business or Crown Class. For short-haul or regional flights, the allowance may be more limited.
