Create Your Email

Students can create accounts at http://my.tcu.edu. Click the Need a TCU UserName? button to get started. A TCU email account is created in conjunction with the normal account creation process. Your TCU ID number is listed in your acceptance letter. Keep in mind that TCU usernames and email addresses are different. Email addresses generally have a period in them while the username will not.

Course Registration

1-9 and Employment Verification

If you will be earning a stipend as a teaching assistant, you will need to complete a 1-9 form.

U.S. Citizens

- Complete and sign the attached Federal I-9 form only Page 1, but bring all pages.
- Bring an original document of your picture ID (Driver's license or student ID) to be copied.
- Bring one of the following original documents: Social Security card, Birth Certificate or current US Passport to be copied.
- Come to the Career Center, suite 1100, first floor, in the Harrison administration building, Mon-Fri 8:00-5:00 during the academic semester to complete the process (or by scheduled appointment during the summer).

International Students

 Upon completion of the I-9 form, specifically pages one and two—which is dependent upon the Social Security number— Students will bring the completed paperwork to the TCU Center for Professional Development Center located in the Harrison, suite 1100, Mon-Fri 8:00-5:00 during the academic semester to complete the process (or by scheduled appointment during the summer). At the completion of that process, you are eligible for employment and in possession of a Social Security number, one which stays with you through your time in the US.

Setting up Direct Deposit

Graduate assistants are paid through Payroll and must use Direct Deposit. Set up Direct Deposit on my.tcu.edu. It usually takes at least one pay period to go into effect. For the first pay date, pick up your check in the HR Payroll Department. Thereafter, the checks go to Direct Deposit if there are no problems. The Payroll Department is located in the TCU Human Resources building at 2701 W. Berry (next to CVS). Contact the Payroll Department if you have any questions or problems at 817-257-7790.
